1. SUMMARY

In terms of Section 24 (5) of the National Environmental Management Act #107 of 1998 (NEMA), the Fish Hoek Valley Ratepayers and Residents Association (FHVRRA) wishes to register as an interested and affected party (I&AP) for public participation process purposes.

As the FHVRRA said in the Chand Environmental Consultants' Rehabilitation of Main Road 14th (pre-PPP) meeting of 10 May and in the False Bay Echo on 15 June 2917, extra parking capacity needs to be added to this area, whichever revision is chosen. Our contention was that some mechanism needs to be built into the solution to pre-warn or close the turning lanes to entering traffic when the parking bays are full so that they don't back-up traffic on along Main Road, as it often does on a busy weekend.

This is not really in our area, but will affect many of us that visit or have to travel through this area. We are supporting the comments made to date by Kalk Bay & St James Ratepayers Association, Alex Bassios, Steve Herberts, Irene Morrison, Gail Daniels, Dawid Mocke, Dr JP Strumpfer and Jane Olive.

We leave the selection of the Revision # with the local residents, but support maximising the number of parking bays.

Our concern at the above mentioned meeting was that this could then have been viewed as Rehabilitation of Main Road project scope creep. As Chand EC has now officially advertised the PPP, we are satisfied that this is now properly in the public domain for comments.

2. RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended that, for the reasons set out in this report:

• That FHVRRA is registered as an interested and affect person (I&AP);
