**SUN VALLEY** 

## 1. DISCUSSION

The lack of street lighting along Kommetjie Road from Four Ways (SVA 240 LHS) to Corsair Way has been reported to the City. This lack of lighting has raised safety and security concerns among the affected residents. Neighbourhood Watch patrols have discovered persons unknown to be found hiding on the residents' properties.

We have been informed that Ian McDonald, <a href="mailto:ian@hho.co.za">ian@hho.co.za</a> Principle Engineer, hho consulting engineers has submitted a request on or about 27 September 2017 to the current road construction's lighting contractor, Willem Louw, <a href="mailto:willem@itsglobal.co.za">willem@itsglobal.co.za</a>, ITS Global for the provision of cantilever lighting in this section. The roadworks and new fill have created low areas between the new road level and houses that are not easily visible from the roadway. Hence at night time, there is a sense of insecurity and thus, the request for this additional lighting.

We feel that now would be an appropriate time to ensure cantilever lighting has indeed been ordered awaiting installation and commissioning. Cantilever lighting has a street light on one side and pedestrian lighting on the other side.

We would appreciate if attention can be focused on a temporary lighting solution as there is no lighting now whatsoever behind Sun Valley and in front of the Evergreen development for some time now.

## 2. RECOMMENDATION

Therefore, for the reasons set out in this report, it is recommended that:

- Temporary lighting be restored along Kommetjie Road from Four Ways to Corsair Way, Sun Valley; and
- Cantilever permanent lighting be commissioned along this route.
