You will be given the opportunity to address the Subcouncil for a maximum of three (3) minutes per issue.

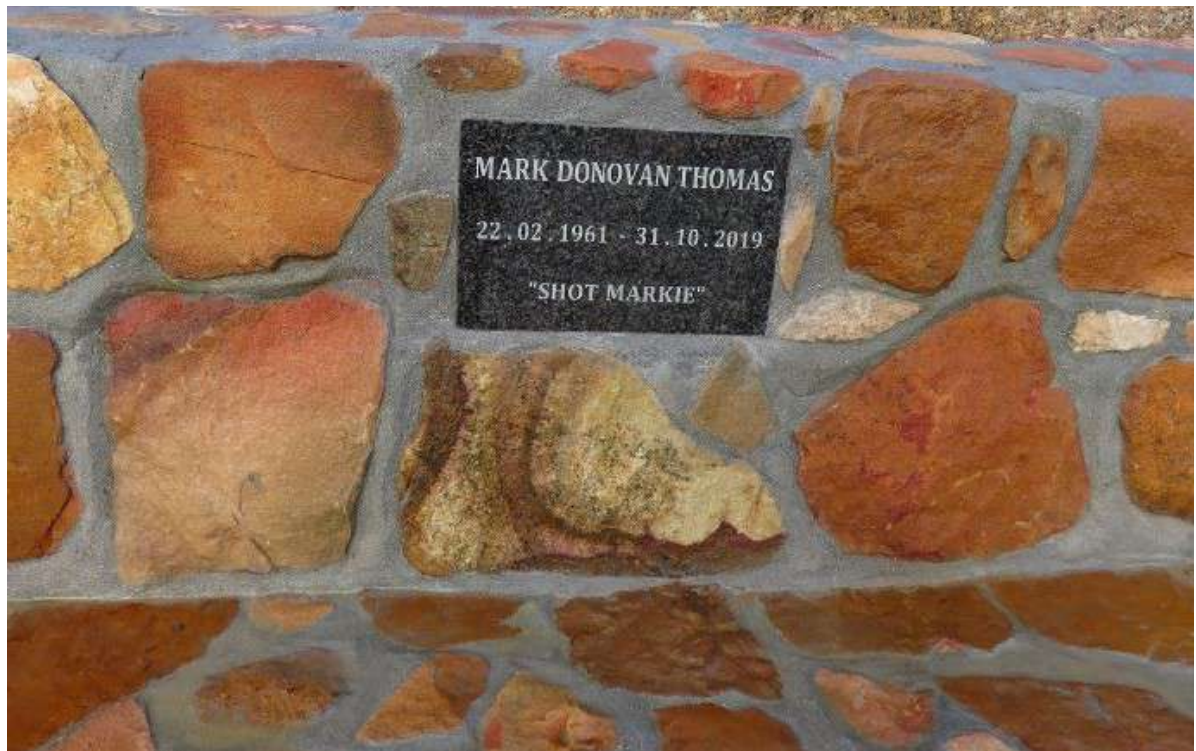

<p style="text-align: center;"><u>ISSUE / TOPIC</u></p> <p>On Jager's Walk and the Fish Hoek Beach promenade there are > 60 concrete benches of the green, yellow, red and blue and peeling variety, > 20 old style wooden benches, > 30 BBBEE disposable benches and now > 20 new rock clad benches.</p> <p>FHVRRA are very pleased to see the new rock benches provided they replace shoddy wooden and concrete benches, conform to not further invading the walkway(as shown in the picture below) and are not built in new locations.</p>	



Many of the old wooden and concrete benches have small commemorative plaques (max 10x5 cm), but the new rock benches are fitted with engraved granite memorial plaques most \pm 30x30cm in size (see picture below). The effect is to turn these new desirable rock clad benches into tombstones.



FHVRRA believes the City must restrict rock and all other new benches to replacing decrepit existing benches and limit the size of memorial plaques to max 10x5 cm.
