<p style="text-align: center;"><u>ISSUE / TOPIC</u></p> <p>Despite the recently agreed emergency response protocols for sewage spills in the Silvermine lower catchment (taking from March to July 2021 to ratify), there have been two “unnoticed” spills on 10 March and 14 April 2022.</p> <p>Before his retirement, Brian Thomson placed funds for the Vallyland Pump Station's generator on the budget, now approved. Apparently his job was split into two and Abongile Duma is rumoured to be responsible for roughly half of his old portfolio, including our area.</p> <p>We beseech the immediate installation and commissioning of a permanent back-up generator at Vallyland Pumping Station #5 to hopefully mitigate future spills at this station which seems incapable of starting after load shedding events, especially due to three pump stations downstream that do have generators. See our February 2021 request.</p>
